The spread of unchecked antisemitism and hate speech on social media is fueling offline violence and harassment. Ahead of Meta's annual meeting, join JLens and ADL for an urgent, action-oriented conversation about JLens' shareholder proposal on Meta's 2026 proxy statement, which calls for greater transparency around how Meta addresses antisemitism and hate on its platforms.

ADL research shows hate and harassment are widespread on Facebook and Instagram, but Meta's enforcement of its own community standards keeps falling short. This session will feature experts from the ADL Center for Technology and Society, and Center on Extremism, including the presentation of a new report analyzing extremist networking on Instagram. Together, they will explain the issues with Meta's current content moderation policies and how attendees can take action to pressure Meta to protect Jewish users and other marginalized communities on its platforms.

## ADL and JLens Urge GE Aerospace Shareholders to Vote AGAINST Proposal 7 in Annual Meeting Proxy

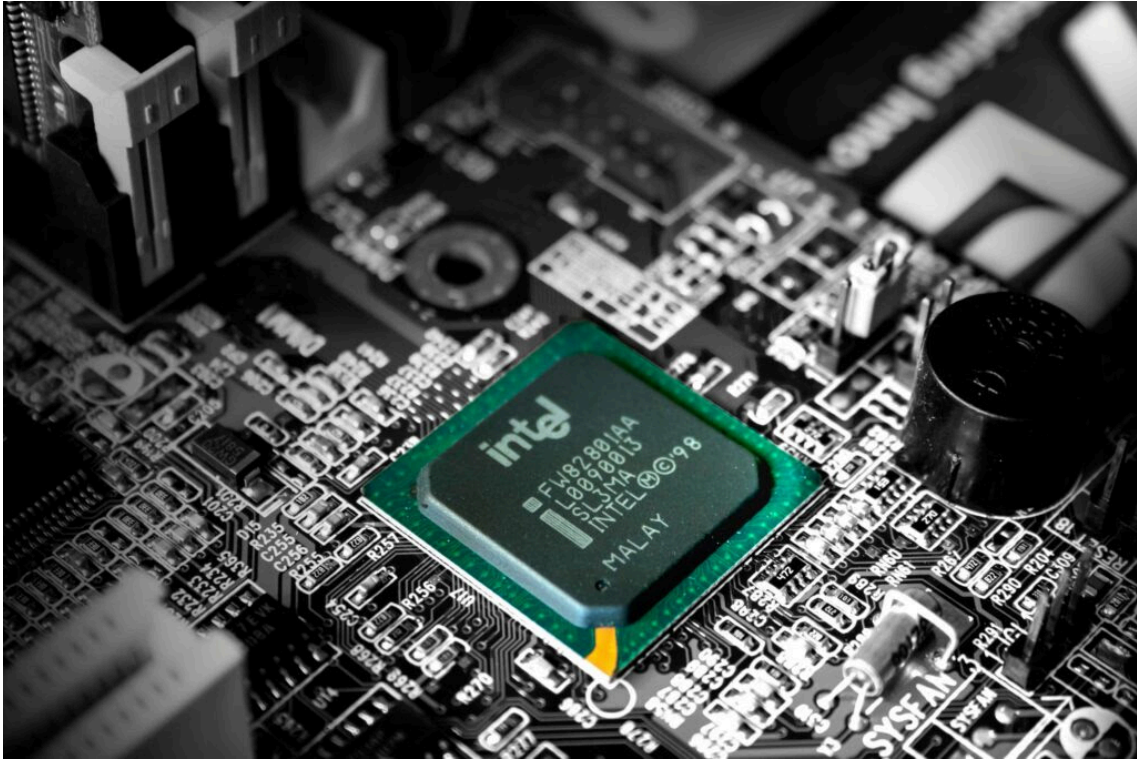
ADL and JLens are urging GE Aerospace shareholders to vote AGAINST Proposal 7 at the company's annual meeting on May 5, 2026. The proposal calls for an independent third-party report on GE Aerospace's due diligence process for defense-related products, but it is focused largely on criticism of the company's business relationships with the Israel Defense Forces. ADL and JLens argue that the proposal is part of a broader BDS-aligned pressure campaign that singles out Israel for discriminatory scrutiny not applied to any other country where GE operates, and that it risks material harm to GE's defense business and shareholder value. JLens has published a full Proxy Memorandum outlining its opposition, and is urging shareholders to vote AGAINST Proposal 7.

## JLens Urges Intel Shareholders to Vote AGAINST Proxy Proposal #7 at Company's May 13th Annual Meeting



The shareholder proposal calls for Intel's Board to report on its human rights due diligence in conflict-affected areas, with specific reference to Israel. JLens argues the proposal aligns with the goals of the BDS movement and is designed to advance geopolitical activism rather than genuine human rights oversight. JLens further contends that Intel's Israeli operations, established in 1974 and now employing over 9,000 people with roughly \$27 billion invested over five decades, are a critical driver of innovation and long-term shareholder value. A similar proposal by the same proponent received only 7% shareholder support at Intel's 2025 annual meeting, and JLens urges shareholders to evaluate the reframed version based on its actual intent and vote against it.
